- un sistem hipertext de stocare și modificare a informațiilor (o bază de date) în care fiecare pagină este ușor editabilă de către orice utilizator care dispune de un navigator Web cu suport pentru formulare

 - WikiWikiWeb = primul Wiki, scris în Perl
 - Portland Pattern Repository = design pattern-uri
 - Scop: interschimb de idei între programatori

O '''bază de date''' reprezintă o modalitate de stocare a unor [[Informație|informații]] (date) pe un suport extern, cu posibilitatea regăsirii acestora.

De obicei o bază de date este memorată într-unul sau mai multe [[fișier|fișiere]]. Bazele de date sunt manipulate cu ajutorul [[Sistem de gestiune a bazelor de date|sistemelor de gestiune a bazelor de date]]. Cel mai răspândit model de baze de date este cel relațional, în care datele sunt memorate în [[tabel|tabele]]. Pe lângă tabele, o bază de date relațională mai poate conține: indecși, proceduri stocate, trigger-e, utilizatori și grupuri de utilizatori, tipuri de date, mecanisme de securitate și de gestiune a tranzacțiilor etc. Alte modele de baze de date sunt modelul ierarhic, modelul orientat-obiect și, mai nou, modelul [[XML]].

Oscar "The Pimp" "Wildebeast" Wilde (-1017 *A.C.* - 1998 *A.C.*), is the son of [Obi-Wan Kenobi](#) and [Willy Wonka](#), was a member of [Riverdance](#), a [Welsh musician](#), [Freemason](#), [time traveler](#), noted wit, professional [trampolinist](#), world [snooker](#) champion, knight, martial artist, linux hacker, former underwear model, inventor of wax, man-about-town, jack of all trades, Microsoft employee, inventor of fast food, record-holder of the Record For Saying [Bugger off](#), older brother of [Optimus Wilde](#) and one of the [greatest men ever to live](#). He was also the Founder, Secretary, and Chief Editor of the [Uncyclopedia](#) and Master of the [Hallowed Book](#). He gave birth to [Pithy Saying Man](#). How this is so remains unknown. [Eric Leavitt](#) is rumoured to know his current location, although he refuses to answer any questions. [Morrissey](#) is currently believed to be his living incarnation, and does not care to deny it.
